London Design Guide focuses on the capital's thriving design scene: its boutiques, vintage dealers, galleries and creative workshops. The guide's editor – design writer and commentator **Max Fraser** – has plucked out the destinations that best reflect the dynamism and vision of the modern design climate and reviewed them by neighbourhood, including user-friendly maps to help navigate the city's sprawl.

More than 150 new and established hotspots are compiled and reviewed, providing a tantalising overview of the design capital of the world. From the galleries of Mayfair to the vintage clusters of Hackney, the furniture showrooms of Clerkenwell and the ever-evolving creative hub of Shoreditch, the guide showcases the diversity of design destinations across the city. In addition, restaurant, bar and café recommendations are featured for each area, selected for both their design credentials and the quality of their food and service.


